Should we talk about money in Church?

The Bible does: Money 123 verses, riches 95 verses, Rich 80 verses Poor 197 verses

The real issue is our hearts - and God cares about our hearts. Jesus spoke of treasures in the Sermon on the Mount and did so in the context of four questions we need to ask about our treasure.

I. Where are you storing your treasures? 19-23

A. On earth - subject to moths, rust and thieves

Today Banks subject to inflation, devaluation and thieves Or stocks subject to volatility, crashes, and thieves

B. In heaven - totally secure

How? - Acts of kindness and generosity

I have held many things in my hands, and I have lost them all; but whatever I have placed in God's hands, that I still possess. Luther

C. The heart is the real issue

We cannot separate our heart from that which it loves. Whether I can give much or little

Jesus commended the widow who gave two mites (two cents)

D. It is the eye (heart desires) that really matter

If your eye is <u>clear or good</u> - means healthy or sincere Seeing clearly we are not blinded by wealth. If your eyes is <u>bad or evil</u> - means malicious or self-centered When we see only our desires our world is in darkness

II. Who are you serving?

A. The Dangers of serving Money

- 1. It is deceiving **Deuteronomy 8:13-14** Leads to pride and forgetfulness
- 2. It is deceitful Matthew 13:22 choking out fruit
- 3. It is disappointing I Timothy 6:6-17 Love of it leads to all kinds of evil
- 4. It can be destructive James 5:1-3

It will testify against us

B. The choices - Hate and love, -Devoted or despise -- God or money

- A. God provides what is needed for life physical and spiritual We are more valuable than the birds Beware of hoarding and greed Luke 12:15
- **B.** God cares for us more than for nature but it is beautiful The issue is our faith -- we have little faith.

- 2. It should be done Generously Mark 12:41-44

- 4. It should be done *According to your ability* 2 Cor. 8:12

C. What does the Bible say about Tithing?

Tithing - giving 10% of all we make

1. It was established before the Law -not a part of the law

Abraham Gen. 14:20, Jacob Gen. 28:22

- 2. It was taught to the people of God as holy Lev. 27:30
- 3. It has to do with our relationship to God Mal. 3:8-12
- 4. It was approved by Christ Matt. 23:23
- 5. It has always been practiced by the evangelical church
