A. The facts of the resurrection

- 1. He was crucified public record
- 2. He died -Attested by soldiers and friends
- 3. He was buried in a tomb -Guards set to watch over it.
- 4. The tomb is empty

No body presented by enemies or disciples Disciples convinced enough to die

We can be forgiven of sin and adopted into the family of God We can truly know peace with God, others and ourselves We can have assurance of eternal life with Christ as He said.

How can we have this peace with God?

Step One- Understand God's Purpose is Peace and Life

God loves you and wants you to experience peace and life--abundant and eternal.

The Bible says..."We have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ." Romans 5:1

"For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life." John 3:16

"I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly." John10:10
Why don't most people have this peace and abundant life that God planned for us to have?

Step Two -Recognize the Problem: Our Separation

God created us in His own image to have an abundant life. He did not make us as robots to automatically love and obey Him. God gave us a will and a freedom of choice.

We chose to disobey God and go our own willful way. This results in separation from God.

Our Attempts to Reach God

Step Three- See God's Bridge: The Cross

Jesus Christ died on the Cross and rose from the grave. He paid the penalty for our sin and bridged the gap between God and people.

The Bible says..."For there is one God and one mediator between God and men, the man Jesus Christ." 1 Timothy 2:5 "For Christ died for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God." 1 Peter 3:18, "But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us." Romans 5:8

Step Four- Our Response is to Receive Christ

We must trust Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior and receive Him by personal invitation. **The Bible says...**

"Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with him, and he with me." Revelation 3:20

"Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God." John 1:12 "That if you confess with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved." Romans 10:9

Here is how you can receive Christ:

- 1. Admit your need (I am a sinner).
- 2. Be willing to turn from your sins (repent).
- 3. Believe that Jesus Christ died for you on the Cross and rose from the grave.
- 4. Through prayer, invite Jesus Christ to come in and control your life through the Holy Spirit. (Receive Him as Lord and Savior.)
