State - *Moses -* Getting comfortable in the wilderness

Israel - Cried out to God

I. Awakened by the Call of God

Exodus 3:1-10

A. Attracted by the never ending power of God

A burning bush that was not consumed

B. Convinced by the never ending compassion of God

1. God identified Himself - God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob

2. God revealed His heart -I have seen, heard, care

3. God revealed His plan Go - I am sending you

II. Acknowledged limitations in the light of God's promised 3:11-4:17

A. Who am I? -- I am a nobody.

11-12

Answer - It does not matter - I am with you

B. Who is sending me? - What is your name? 13-22

Answer - I AM who I AM - ever present one, Eternal 13-14

- God of your fathers - Faithful 15

- God of compassion - 16-18

- God almighty - miracles 19-20

- God of Abundance 21-22

C. What if they will not believe me? What do I have to offer? 4:1-9

Answer - What is in your hand? - a shepherd's staff
His identity and his abilities- 3 miracles

God can restore, heal and control the world

D. I am not eloquent - What will I say? 10-12

Answer - Who made man's mouth? Who controls his senses? Twofold answer- I will be with your mouth = ability to speak

I will teach you what to say = words

E. Could you send someone else? Could others do it better? 13-17

Answer - will not be alone Aaron your brother

Go! And take your staff with you!!

III. Accepted his place of service

4:18-31

- A. Sought permission from father-in-law
- B. Accepted the covenant of God for his sons
- C. Met with Aaron Aaron bowed and worshipped

What should we learn about God from his call?

- 1. God hears and sees the misery of His people
- 2. God chooses who will serve Him in love
- 3. God has equipped us to serve Him
- 4. We are not called to serve alone
- 5. God prepares us for the battles ahead

What can we expect in service to the King?

- 1. Expect to be stretched beyond your comfort zone
- 2. Expect to face your weaknesses
- 3. Expect to touch lives of those needing God
- 4. Expect to be changed for life

What excuses to we need to overcome

1. "I am a nobody" Low self-esteem
God is with us - He calls us His child

- 2. "I don't know enough about God" Lack of clear relationship God is ever present, almighty and loving we are His family
- 3. "I have no authority" Fear of the rejection of others
 God has equipped you to serve Him
- 4. "I have no ability" what can I do God created you for the task
- 5. "Someone else can do it better" can't someone else do it God has chosen you and will give you victory
