The perfect time - In the fullness of Time -The perfect plan -God sent His Son, born of a woman, under the law The perfect redemption - in order to redeem, to adopt us as children

I. Man's original state - created by God

A. Created in the image of God - Genesis 1:26-27

B. Created to have fellowship with God - Genesis 3:8

They heard the sound of God walking in the Garden - calling

II. Man's fallen state - corrupted by sin

 - 2. We cry with intimacy Abba father Abba is also Father but on a personal level

Jesus in garden of Gethsemane - Mark 14:36 Paul makes it the sign of our relationship with God *Romans 8:14-16 For those who are led by the Spirit* of God are the children of God. The Spirit you received does not make you slaves, so that you live in fear again; rather, the Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship. And by him we cry, "Abba, Father." The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children.

- 2. Serve <u>without fear</u> Our Father knows us, our strengths and weaknesses
- 3. Serve in <u>holiness</u> Belonging totally to the Father
- 4. Serve in <u>righteousness</u> Keeping a clear conscience with others
- 5. Serve <u>all our days</u> There is sufficient strength in Christ
