If the gospel is grace alone, then every conversion is a miracle." - Tim Keller Definition Grace alone means that God loves, forgives, and saves us not because of who we are or what we do, but because of the work of Christ. We are not saved by obeying a list of do's and don'ts, but by grace through faith in Christ. Our salvation is in God's hands. God's Word says that we are saved by grace through faith in Christ Jesus and not by our own efforts or works (Ephesians 2:8-9). Grace Alone. Faith Alone. Grace alone means that God loves, forgives, and saves us not because of who we are or what we do, but because of the work of Christ.
