Any structure must have a foundation - the higher the structure, the deeper the foundation must go. The Church, now over 2000 years old, has a deep foundation. In the Book of Acts we find the Pattern (Events and decisions), the Principles for those patterns and the Purpose for us today

Judea and Samaria Acts 8:1-12:25 Ends of the Earth Acts 13:1-28:31

Author: The book of Acts was written by Luke, a Greek physician. He also wrote the Gospel of Luke. Luke and Acts, up to chapter 16 were written as a result of research, then in Acts 16 we see Luke has joined Paul on his missionary trips.

Receipient: Theophilus (meaning lover of God) called "Most Excellent" in Luke 1:3. Could have been a member of High Priests family.

Content: "All that Jesus began – to teach and to do" Acts 1:1

Called: Acts of Apostles and of Holy Spirit

Date: A.D. 63 - before death of Paul or destruction of Jerusalem

1:1-14 Introduction to whole

Burning Question – Now Lord "restore" = Show us your power

Answer – when God says = Power is coming but not like you think

- 1. Many convencing proofs appeared many times
- 2. 40 days no question of resurrection

B. The Kingdom of God

- 1. Used over 50 xs in Matthew and 30 xs in Luke
- 2. The sphere of God's rule moral and spiritual force

C. Repentance for the Forgiveness of sin

- 1. No other religion offers it by grace
- 2. Essential message according to Luke 24:47

D. The Baptism of the Spirit

- 1. Foretold by John the Baptist Matthew 3:11
- 2. Promised by Christ in

At beginning of Christ's ministry Luke 3:16-17
At the end of His earthly ministry Luke 24:44-49
After the resurrection Acts 1:5

E. The Second Coming of Christ

- 1. Angel sent just to make sure there was no mistake
 Two men same discription in Luke 24:4
- 2. He is coming again to the earth
