--Deuteronomy 6:4-7 [NAS]







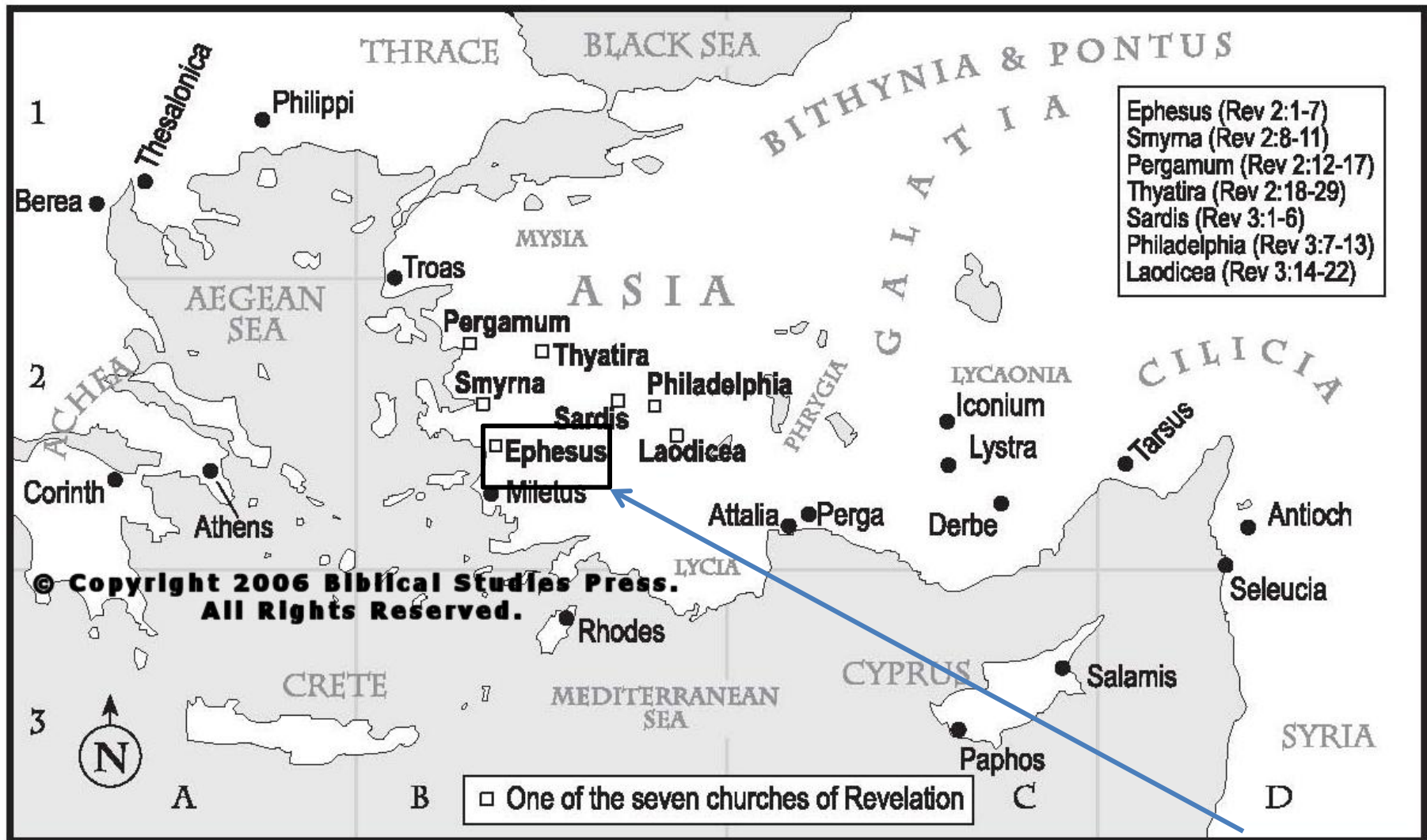

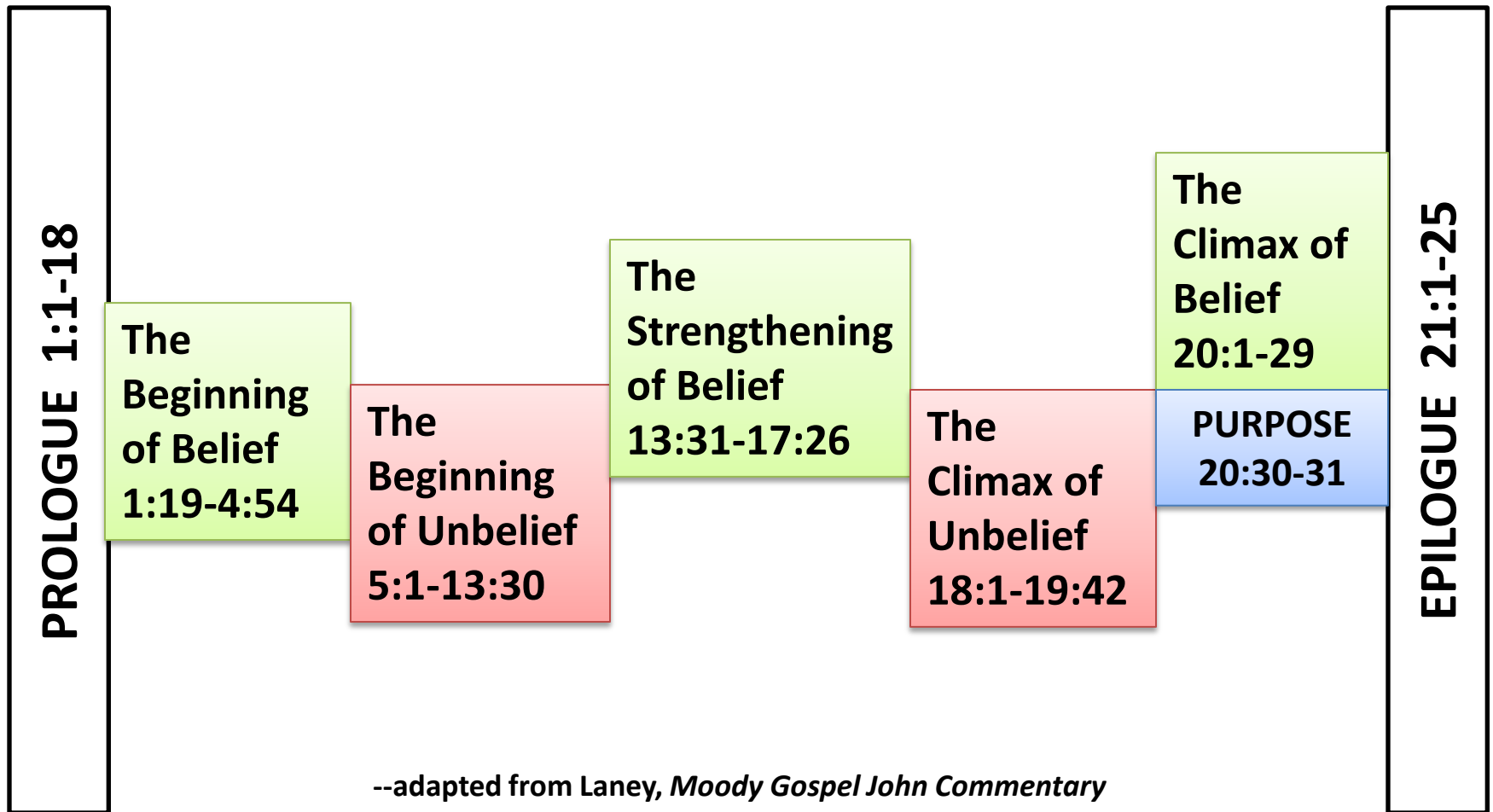

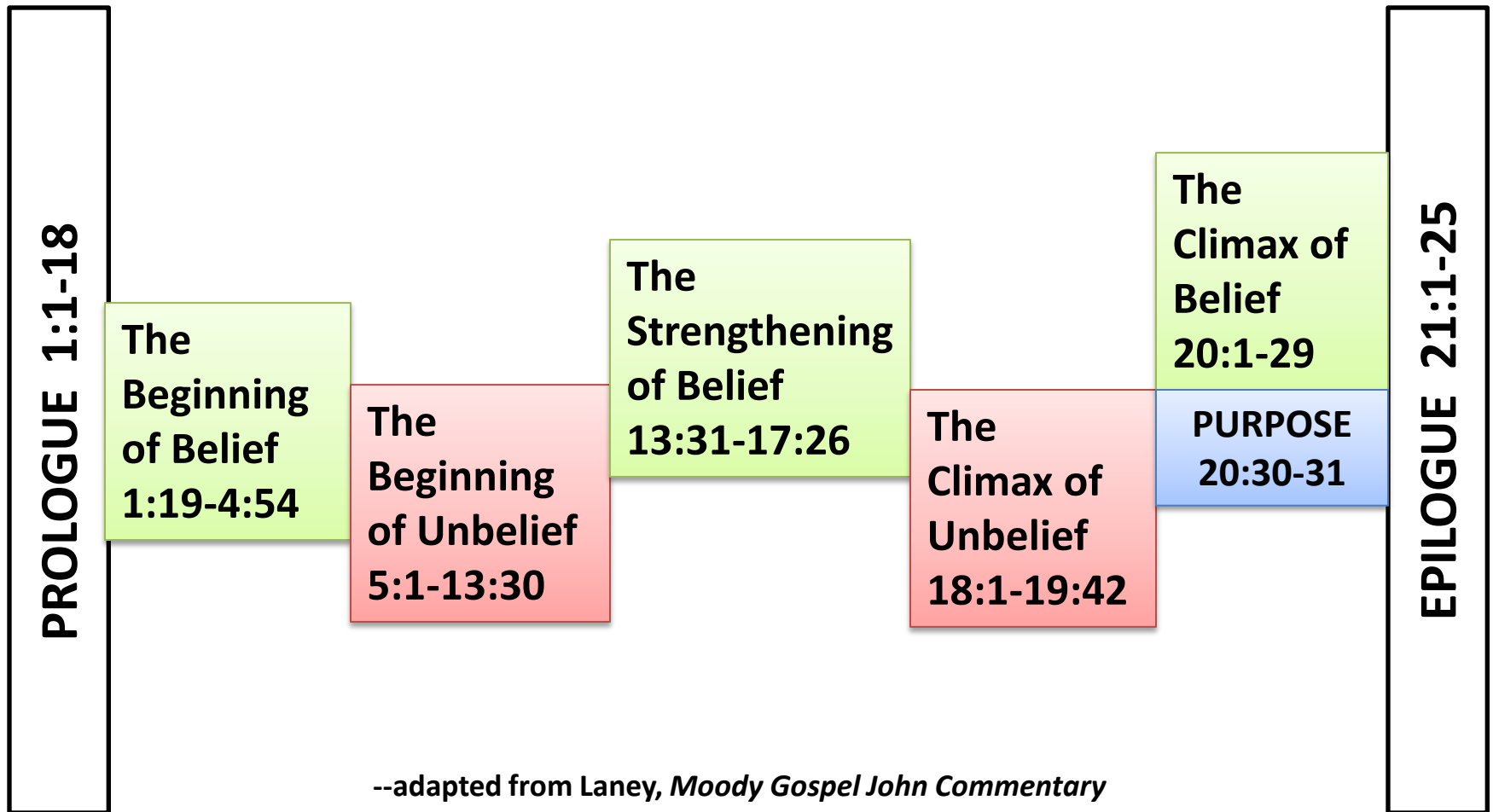


John 20:30-31 [NAS]
